If you want to attend, **make sure that your parents/carers have given you permission by signing in your planner.**

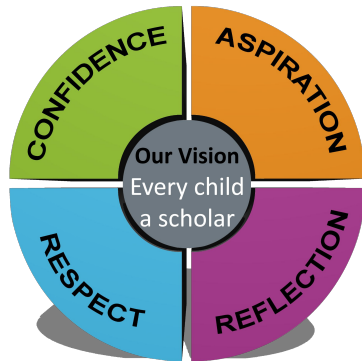


If you want to attend, **make sure that your parents/carers have given you permission by signing in your planner.**

What do students need to do?

- Record homework in their **student planners**.
- Use ClassCharts to check their homework deadlines and any links.
- Ask if they do not understand the homework assigned.
- If they need help or a place to work, they must get permission from parents/carers to attend KS3 Homework Support/KS4 Prep.
- They will complete their homework to be best of their ability.
- They will make their best effort to catch up on any missed homework.

What happens if students do NOT do their homework?

- If homework is incomplete, not of an appropriate standard or not attempted then they will be issued with a D1 point and will have to attend KS3 Homework Support/KS4 Prep the next day for at least 30 minutes.
- If they fail to attend the KS3 Homework Support/KS4 Prep, they will be issued with D2 points which is a lunchtime detention the next day.

What will we do?

- We will remind students to record their homework in their **student planners**.
- We will set quality homework and post it onto classcharts.
- We will support students in the KS3 Homework Support/KS4 Prep if they need help or a place to work.
- We will share examples of excellent work across the school on a Wall of Fame as well as the website.
- We will award Aspiration Cornerstone points for homework that goes beyond expectations.
- We will have a raffle draw each half term - details on the next slide.
- If two or more homework assignments from a subject are missed their teacher will contact home.

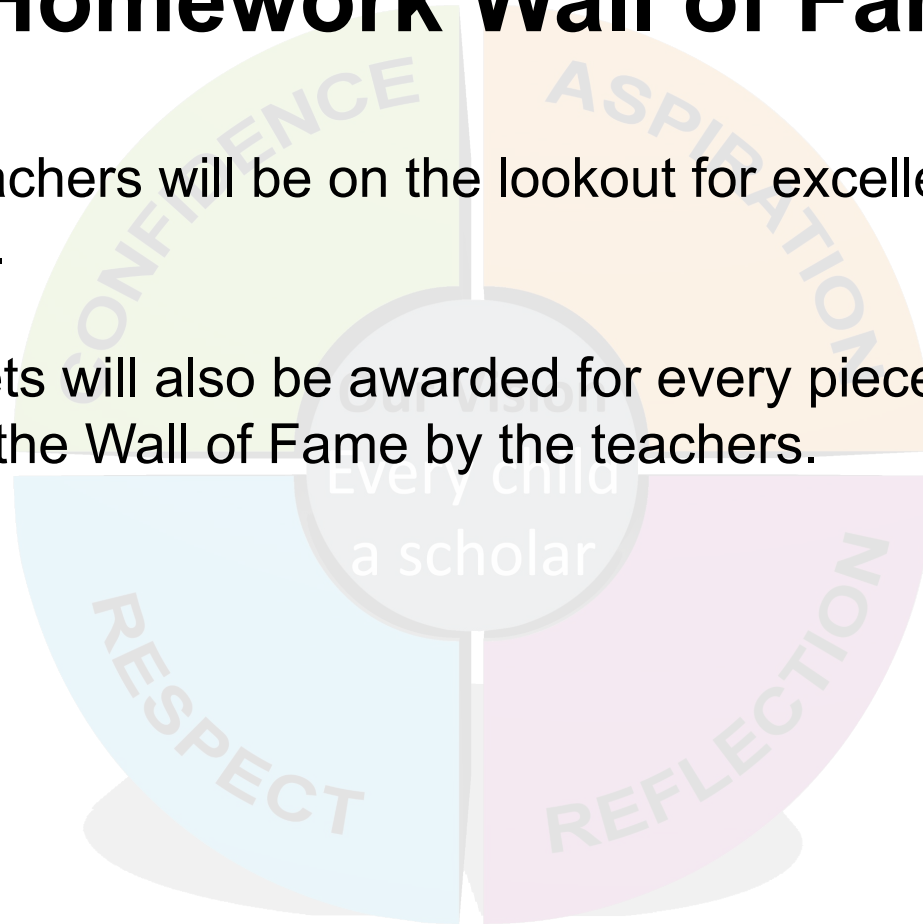
The Raffle Draw
