A SNAPSHOT OF OUR YEAR TOGETHER

In 2022-23 **Into**University worked with a total of **133** students from Arts and Media School Islington across a number of different programmes. This academic year, **122** students took part in the Secondary FOCUS programme.

- **72%** The percentage of students from Arts and Media School Islington returning each year to the programme between Y7-11.
- 4 Students that have an IntoUniversity Mentor
- 42 The number of students attending our programmes outside of school
- 23 The number of students who attend our free after school Academic Support Club
